MAJOR SERVICES

Emergency Department: full-service, 24-hour emergency department with 44 treatment rooms, including two trauma bays, and Level 3 Bronze Geriatric Accreditation

Intensive Care Unit: 12 state-of-the-art beds supported by intensivist services

Surgical Care Center: 10 surgical suites for inpatient and outpatient surgeries, including robotic surgery, eye surgery and endoscopy

Family Birthing Center: 10 labor/delivery/recovery/postpartum rooms; 1 tub room for labor pain management; 3 triage rooms; newborn nursery; birth planner services; lactation consultant and support; and WIC assistance on site

Parkview Rehabilitation Center: 50-bed unit, CARF-accredited for Comprehensive Inpatient Medical Rehabilitation, Stroke and Brain Injury programs; CRRN staff and certified brain injury specialists; and Activities of Daily Living (ADL) suite

Parkview Outpatient Therapy: occupational, physical and speech therapy services

Parkview Center for Wound Healing: 3,000 square-foot center includes two fully private, glass-enclosed hyperbaric chambers and four exam rooms, where the latest approaches in wound care and hyperbaric medicine are practiced

Outpatient Infusion Center: two private infusion suites with capacity for 12 patients to receive hydration, antibiotics or other infusion medications



Parkview Hospice, Palliative Care, Home Infusion and Parkview Health at Home: holistic, personalized care to individuals with a terminal illness who wish to focus on comfort and quality of life. The care team consists of specially trained nurses, social workers, chaplains, physicians and nurse practitioners, massage and music therapists, certified nursing assistants and volunteers.

Sleep Disorders Center: eight-bed center, accredited by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine for the diagnosis and treatment of sleep-related disorders, that performs sleep studies for adults and children

Community Nursing: Parkview registered nurses offer a variety of health-related services and education in local schools and throughout surrounding communities.

Parkview Community Greenhouse & Learning Kitchen: provides greater access to fresh, affordable produce and engages our community with opportunities to learn new skills at home—in the kitchen and the garden.

Parkview Health Graduate Medical Education: Graduate Medical Education is located at Parkview Hospital Randallia and offers resident physicians the opportunity to rotate through 12 facilities in northeast Indiana. The Parkview Residency Center is a state-of-the-art facility that includes Internal Medicine, Transitional Year, General Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology and Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, offering patients the opportunity to have a resident physician as part of their care team.
